Dear Parent/Carer,

As we reach the end of term, I would like to take the opportunity to revisit our school uniform expectations.

Uniform is an important part of school's identity. It reinforces who we are as a community and helps allow our learners to feel pride in their school.

It would be fair to say that, in the last few weeks, we have had a number of interpretations of what is and is not acceptable uniform, so, it is now time to clarify our expectation for learners and parents/carers.

Please see below list of expectations:

- Black trousers
- Blue polo t-shirt
- Blue Jumper
- All black shoes/trainers
- If ears are pierced, only studs should be worn (no loops)
- Make-up – minimal for Y9 and above
- No false eyelashes and false nails

Learners should arrive every day in full school uniform (as set out above), if they have PE, the PE kit should be brought into school in a bag and changing facilities will be provided.

Starting from tomorrow we will be checking learners are wearing the correct uniform on their arrival at school. For learners who turn up in incorrect uniform we will contact you to discuss, and may send learners home to get the correct uniform.
